

Back numbers will be exchanged, if in good condition, for corresponding bound volumes in gold cloth, with gilt top, for \$1.00 per volume (six numbers); half russia for \$2.25; olive-green cloth, plain top, 75 cents each; subscribers paying charges both ways. Postage on The Centurky volumes, 38 cents. All numbers sent for binding should be marked with owner's name. We cannot bind or exchange copies the edges of which have been trimmed by machine. Cloth covers for binding The Centurky, 50 cents. Volumes end with April and October numbers.
