Responsibilities:

- Supervise a team of Nutrition Research Assistants and provide on-going training as needed
- Communicate effectively with Program Manager, Head and Sous Chef to address additional training needs
- Follow food safety guidelines and HACCP regulations in basic food preparation
- Check participants in and out, keeping track of uneaten food
- Weigh participant's food to exact amounts
- Measure hot portion of meals when participants arrive
- Obtain ingredients from dry storage and different refrigerators
- Clean working area after each meal is prepared
- Stock food and paper goods
- Manage time effectively to produce several meals in advance
- Work with dietitians to ensure quality, accuracy, and prevention of contamination by allergens
- Precise weighing of ingredients and foods for service
- Strong attention to detail is critical
