

## **Framingham State Food Study Policies and Procedures**

### **ID cards for Community Participants:**

During Cohorts 2 (and 3), the Study reached out to the Community for potential participants. Community participants came to campus Monday-Friday to eat at least one meal on campus and pick-up the other meals; this meal could be breakfast, lunch, or dinner.

Campus Police expressed a security concern about community participants: how to limit the campus accessibility of a participant to Dining Services, limit the use of the Athletic Center for example, all versus the fact that it is a public campus.

The decision was made to issue a separate Framingham State Food Study/Framingham State University picture ID card. Subjects visited the Campus ID office the end of August/early September in combination with their initial pre-Study assessment appointments to have their picture taken and receive the ID card.
